GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Picture's Up project was created to give participants the opportunity to increase their knowledge and skills in the use of film and the theater to convey message. We want this project to encourage young people to become interested in art and to find new, creative ways to use it. In order to achieve this, participants will take part in many activities that will enable them to let go of their imagination. Together, among others, we will make films and perform theater plays. In addition, an important aspect of the exchange will be getting the knowledge of the history of all partner countries about the theater, cinema and the censorship and propaganda that was applied there. Each of us will be able to participate actively and will have an equal contribution to the course of the exchange. The exchange will involve 40 people from eight European Union countries: Poland, Spain, Portugal, Italy, Greece, Bulgaria, Czech Republic and France.

WITH PICTURE'S UP:

- You will gain knowledge about the history of cinematography of the partner countries.
- You will find out how propaganda systems functioned in the countries participating in the project.
- You will have the opportunity to meet interesting and creative young people from different parts of Europe.
 - You will make a joint youth project with us.
- You will learn new skills like: planning the activities, working in an international group, presenting yourself.
 - You will also see Cracow !!!

MOTIVATION/ APPROACH

If you want to acquire new knowledge, get to know new people, you are creative and your motivation for action is big, this project is for you. Picture's up is a project that takes a lot of action and requires a lot of commitment, but also is a project thanks to which, in addition to active participation, you will spend a great time in Cracow.

RECRUITMENT PROCESS

1. Project partners are responsible for recruiting. Once your membership has been approved by the organization, we will send you an application form to be completed within 7 days of the date of your submission.

PREPARATION

To participate in our project you need to prepare properly. Our project assumes active youth participation from the preparation phase to the completion and dissemination phase of the project.

- Each group must prepare a presentation on the culture and traditions of its country. During the project there will be two intercultural nights during which we will present our countries. Time for presentation is max 10 min. * If you need an access to the kitchen, let us know 3 days before the project.
- Each group must prepare a presentation about the history of a censorship and propaganda that was used in your countries. The presentation is about censorship and propaganda in the press, radio and television. Time for presentation is max 10 min.
- Each group must make a film in which you will present the history of theatre and cinematography in your countries. Note! Movies must be done by you. The movie can last up to 10 min + you get 5 min to comment on your video.

WARNING !!! There will be no time to prepare the abovementioned presentations during the exchange. You must do it before coming to Cracow. !!!

We want the presentations to be creative, well prepared and interesting. We do not want to restrict you only to power point. The more interesting and creative the idea, the better. After all, we do not want to bore the whole group :)

On the project we will record promotional films so if you have the ability to bring a laptop or camera with you it will be very useful. However, if you do not have such a possibility no worries. Together we can manage.



DISSEMINATION PROCESS

After the project, each partner organization must prepare activities to disseminate results and pass the knowledge gained on the project to staff of the organization or local community. These actions can take the form of:

- workshops
- trainings
- happenings

You decide how you want to spread the knowledge gained on the project. However, this is a mandatory element that every organization must carry out after the project. Most projects end with the departure of the participants, our project is different because in addition to the project activities everyone must give something out of himself and show what we did in their local communities.

Preparation of workshops is necessary to receive reimbursement of travel expenses.

ACCOMODATION

Momotown Hostel is located in the historic part of Cracow. Hostel is located in the city center in the Kazimierz district.

The reception is open all the time and is available to assist you in any way.

Just around the corner is New Square with the best pubs of Kazimierz. The most important sights of Cracow are also in close proximity - Wawel (10 minutes) and Old town (15 minutes)(Train / bus station is a 15 minute walk or 3 tram stops).

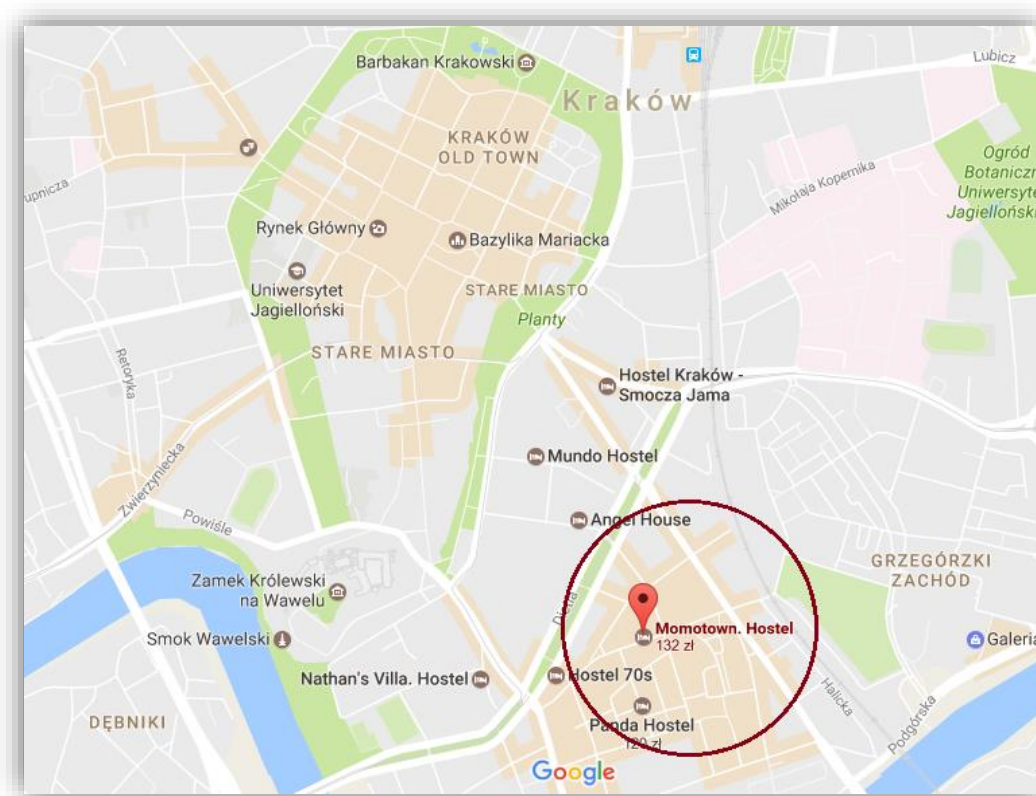


HOW TO GET THERE ?

From the airport to the train station there is a comfortable bus.

The train / bus station is approximately 15 minutes away. You have to go Westerplatte street to Main Post Office, turn left into Starowiślna street (do not confuse with Wielopole), pass the Dietla Street and continue straight down Starowiślna Street to Miodowa Street at number 28.

You can also take tram no 3, 19, 24 (stop Miodowa).

INFORMATION CONCERNING THE RETURN OF TRAVEL EXPENSES

- Travel costs are reimbursed under the condition of participation in all activities.
- Travel expenses are reimbursed up to 30 days from the date of receipt by Youth Human Impact of the results of the project dissemination activities, and a complete set of documents such as travel reimbursement forms and original tickets.
- Only class II or Economy Class tickets are eligible for reimbursement of costs.

PLACE

Krakow is one of the most beautiful Polish cities, with a tradition dating back more than 1000 years. Anyone who was once in this city will not forget the impression left by the climate of the old castle walls, the Wawel hill with the dragon cave, stretching just above the lazy river of the Vistula, a charming market with the beautiful St. Mary's Church and plenty of well-kept greenery. It is difficult to talk about the monuments of Cracow, because almost the entire city is one big monument. Maybe it would be advisable to exclude only modern housing estates from this area, but still the entire city center is worth admiring during family walks.

As a member of the European Union, Poland has agreements for the recognition of insurance systems. In Poland silent hours are from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.

In Poland, there is a total ban on drinking alcohol in public places such as railway stations, parks, streets. Breaking this law threatens the mandate of the altitudes of 100 zł = 25 euro
In Poland, there is also a ban on smoking in public places such as cinemas, theatres, railway stations, airports, and bus stops. Sometimes in these places it is a special place for smoking.
