How To Reach Ankara, Turkey

1) Arrival To Istanbul

If you book your ticket for Istanbul Atatürk Airport;

Atatürk Airport has its own Metro station beneath the terminals.

You should have a minimum 6 TL in coins to buy Metro tokens (jeton) from a Jetonmatik machine at the Havalimanı (Airport) Metro station. Small TL notes (bills: TL5, TL10) may work, but often the machines will not accept them. Unfortunately, there is no way to get coins at the Metro station, and once you're at the station, you would have to go through the security check again to re-enter the airport terminals to find coins.

Pass through the turnstile, descend the escalator (or elevator) and board a Metro train for direction to **Yenikapı**. The Havalimanı (Airport) Station is the end of this Metro line, so you can board any train—they all go towards Yenikapı. You can't get the wrong train.☺ Stay on the Metro to the **Otogar station**, the 10th stop. Take the escalator up and you'll be at the heart of Istanbul's **Büyük Otogar** (Main Intercity Bus Terminal).

If you book your ticket for Istanbul SabihaGökçen Airport;

- You can book another flight from Sabiha Gökçen to Ankara Esenboga Airport by Pegasus. The price of flight tickets are mostly same as bus tickets.
- Note: SabihaGökçen Airport is quite far from the center of Istanbul. We do not recommend you to book your tickets to this destination. *In case, you don't have any other option, please contact with the project coordinator.*

2) Arrival To Ankara

If your flight is directly to Ankara Esenboga Airport;

- If you book direct ticket to Ankara, you need to take the shuttle to the city center. You will use Havaş Shuttle which costs 10 TL for each person/one way.
- If a big number of participants use Ankara Airport, coordinators will arrange private bus. *That's why please inform us as soon as you book your tickets.*

Accommodation and Food

Accommodation and food will be covered at 100%. Participants will be hosted in triple bed rooms with private bathroom, fridge, air conditioning, TV, free access to internet. Participants will be assigned to their rooms on arrival.
