The main objective of the project: to improve the level of key competences and skills of young people in the field of youth involvement in public life, including those with fewer opportunities, as well as to promote participation in democratic life in Europe.

The main activity of the project is an 8 days exchange programme organized in <u>Satu Mare</u> (arrival on <u>September 3, 2016</u> afternoon and departure on <u>September 10, 2016</u>), <u>Romania</u> with the purpose of offering young people good examples, tools to increase the participation of young people in the democratic life in Europe, and the opportunity to reflect on best opportunities to have a say in public life. The program will include formal and non-formal learning sessions, on site visits to public authorities and NGOs, followed by debates, role plays, reflections.

Participants:

4 young people (age 18-30) and 1 group leader per each partner (no age limit)

The partners shall strongly encourage the participation of young people from disadvantaged groups, especially from rural areas and minority groups, which have less opportunities to express

themselves and become involved in public life, but which have proved in the past the desire to become active in students' councils, youth organizations. Each participating organization shall be responsible for the selection of the participants based on the condition that they pay attention to the above selection criteria. The selections criteria shall take into account: the youth educational and extra-curricular experience, family income level, social problems (raised by single parents, numerous brothers etc.), ethnic/cultural, background. The partner organization shall pay a specific attention when selecting their participants to the sex ratio balance. In this sense, we expect that an equal number of boys and girls shall take part in the exchange.

All participants are expected to be able to understand and speak in English.

By the end of the project, each participant shall be able to fill in its own Youthpss Certificate.

It is strongly recommended for the group leader to be employee of the partner organization and/or to already have experience in this field and acted as supervisor in other international projects.

Travel

Each participant organization shall be responsible for choosing the best travel solution in terms of money and time spent. The travel costs for tall the participation shall be reimbursed according to the travel distance:

The travel costs shall be reimbursed to partners after the receipt of the documents justifying the expenditures with travel.

Accommodation and meals

The main applicant shall be responsible for providing accommodation and meals during the exchange programme. Special attention is to be paid also to vegetarians and any people intolerant to some food or ingredients. If this is the case for some participants, please let us know in due time!

Health insurances

All participants are required to have an European health insurance card in case accidents/ilnesses!!

Communication and dissemination

All of the partners shall be responsible for updating their websites, in case they have one and post at least two news on the project, after the signing of the financing contract and at the end of the exchange programme, containing mandatory the following elements: the title of the project, objective, budget, financing programme, partners involved, implementation period and a short description of the Erasmus+ programme along with its logo. If possible, these news shall also be disseminated to the local public using the local media. The partners shall publish on their website the final report of the project elaborated by the applicant organization and distribute it among relevant stakeholders. Please send us a link or a print screen with the news on your website, facebook account etc. for the records.

Participant organizations are expected to organize a session with all of their members and present the project and its main results and try to develop plans on how to use this information and knowledge in order to design activities that contribute directly to raising the level of participation of young people in the life of the community. Participants are expected to do their utmost to use the lessons learned during the exchange programme in order to stimulate the participation of youth in public life and to become themselves active agents in their societies.

All of the involved partners shall use in their communication materials the logo and a short description of the Erasmus+ project together with the mention that the project has been financed by this programme.

Evenings:

Each evening one of the partner organization shall be responsible to organize with the support of the applicant organization a cultural evening of their own in which to present elements of their national/regional/local culture: a movie, a song, a poem, dance, traditional food etc.
