

Why do we have this project?

This project has been inspired by the many stories of young people with big dreams and desires who often cannot realise them because they can't afford it.

We have also been in this situation - not knowing how to handle our money and wondering why it is never enough although we have an income. Having learned the simple rules of financial independence, we as the informal group Bees Empowered have decided to organise this project in order to give 42 young people the opportunity to learn from each other about how to manage their money and realise their dreams.

We believe money is a very sensitive topic to talk about and we'd like to elevate it by bringing together young people with different perspectives. Last but not least, the project aims to improve the employability and the economic independence of youth.

How is the youth exchange built up?

Where: Ommen, The Netherlands


When: 24 April till 5 May 2017

Expenses: Food, accommodation and activities are paid for by the Erasmus+ programme. Travel expenses are reimbursed according to the Erasmus+ rules and the distance the participants will travel.

Travel: participants from Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Greece, Italy, Lithuania and Romania receive a reimbursement of EUR 170 for their travel.

Participation fee: 50 EUR paid upon arrival during registration. The money covers the necessary materials used throughout the youth exchange.
