The youth exchange will create a safe space for the youngsters to exchange good practices and learn from each other.

Objectives of the Youth Exchange:

- Aim: increase economic independence of youngsters and tackle their economic exclusion
- Aim: address youth unemployment & self-sufficiency of youngsters from disadvantaged backgrounds
- empower youngsters to distinguish between their needs and wants
- increase young people's knowledge on managing their finances
- improve the youngsters' saving habits
- empower youngsters to realise their dreams by setting and achieving their saving goals
- explore the topic of pocket money together
- exchange opinions with peers and learn from each other on how to make healthy financial choices
- priority is given to youngsters from rural areas, minorities, regions with high unemployment rate, early school leavers
- develop entrepreneurial skills: how to manage their finances when starting up a new business.
- learn how to manage their debts and manage the risks of borrowing money

Youth leader profile:

#### The profile of **the ideal youth leader** is:

=> works with youngsters from disadvantaged background.

=> supports youngsters in their professional development.

=> does career counselling in schools or universities.

=> during the youth exchange leads sessions (optional) and supports the learning process of participants.

=> takes care of the safety of participants, encourages a positive working environment and acts as mediator if conflicts arise.

=> helps with small logistical tasks during the event.

NB:The youth leader has to be able to come both to the Advanced Planning visit that will take place from 3 till 6 February 2017 and the actual youth exchange that will take place from 24 April till 5 May 2017.

Where: Ommen, The Netherlands

When: APV: 3 till 6 February 2017

Youth exchange: 24 April till 5 May 2017

Who: APV: one representative per country.

YE: 7 countries with 6 participants per country (5 participants and 1 youth leader per country)

Expenses: Food, accommodation and activities are paid for by the Erasmus+ programme. Travel expenses are reimbursed according to the Erasmus+ rules and the distance the participants will travel.

Participation fee for the YE: 50 EUR paid upon arrival during registration. The money covers the necessary materials used throughout the youth exchange.
