Dates of youth exchange: 23rd - 29th July 2019 (7 days of activities)

Departure day: 30th July 2019 (until 12:00 h.)

PARTICIPANTS

Age: from 18 years to 25 years old (except youth leaders)

Number of participants per organization: 5 (4 participants + 1 youth leader)



Target group:

- \bullet Young people who would like to try something new and who would like to discover non-formal education and its possibilities and advantages
- Young people who are interested in green jobs and in green economy in order to see future opportunities of working in this sector



- Young people who are motivated to try new things and to discover the world of the sustainable development, green jobs, green industries, ecology, etc.
- Young people who would like to get known more about different cultures and habits and who would like to practice foreign languages and share their experience with others

Gender balance is recommended and the application form is available and ready to be fill and send to the organization in your country.

THE PURPOSE OF THE PROJECT

Youth unemployment (Youth not in employment, education or training = NEET) rates are generally much higher, even double or more than double, than unemployment rates for all ages. In 2015 youth unemployment rate in Europe reached 16,3 percent. Young people under 25 are facing a lot of difficulties to find a job, especially these ones who doesn't have any diplomas.

Since six years, an environmental education organization 3PA (Penser=Think, Parler=Talk, Partager=Share, Agir=Act) is developing a project named "European school of the ecological transition" which aim is to discover the possibilities of the sustainable development, green economy, the energy transition and green jobs which are taking in mind a big social aspect and integration.

Today, we would like to for the second time add an inter-cultural dimension in our project with sharing our knowledge with others.

OBJECTIVES

- to make young people not only in Europe more aware about green jobs and their possibilities to find a work in this field or similar one
- to extend knowledge of young people in the field of ecology, eco-citizenship and green economy
- to allow young people to be also actors and not only consumers
- to allow young people to live new experience in the foreign country and to support the idea of youth mobility as a learning possibility
- to help young people ask questions about their own identities, ideas, culture and the identity of the environment where they are living
- to work and share experience with open-mind and without prejudices and stereotypes
- to provide local, international organizations and NGOs with new tools to conceive and implement actions and projects of youth employment in the sustainable development

TRAVEL AND VISA COSTS

A certain amount of the travel cost is refunded depending on countries. The travel amount is anticipated by participants and then refunded upon the presentation of the travel documents. Food and accommodation are covered at 100% by the project. Visa costs are also covered, please contact us or your sending organization for further information if you need Visa.

We will refund directly all the sending organizations/participants after the end of the project, as soon as we receive all the tickets and air boarding passes A/R in original and as soon as we receive the second instalment from the EACEA. The bank transfer will be done to the bank account of the sending organization that afterwards will forward them to the participants bank account or we will transfer it directly to the participants as partners prefer. Normally the refund process can take, approximately, 1 - 2 months.

Below you can see the maximum refundable amount for the travel costs per country and per participant. Tickets (flight-train-bus-metro) must be second class to be eligible. Taxi is not eligible and refundable cost.

INSURANCE

Participants are required to bring their own Health Insurance Card if they have one. However, it's strongly recommend that all the participants organize their own personal health and travel insurance before they leave their home country. Participants are not insured for personal belongings and neither the 3PA can be held responsible for their personal belongings during the project.

Please keep all documents as we need the originals of:

- Invoices of flight tickets, train tickets, bus tickets, etc.
- Boarding passes
- Visa invoice



HOW TO GET TO MEETING POINTS

- One meeting point will be at the AIRPORT TOULOUSE BLAGNAC
- If you will use the opportunity to travel by bus or train what is more than «ecologically» recommended by us :-) we also recommend you to take tickets to the railway station: TOULOUSE MATABIAU or to the bus station: GARE ROUTIERE DE TOULOUSE and from there you can take direct train to the city called MURET where the duration of the journey is about 20 minutes and cost of the ticket is 4.80 \bigcirc .

As soon as we will receive all the arrival's information we will fix the meeting point schedules and keep the participants informed. Please send your e-tickets (that should include your name, the price, date and time) as soon as possible so that we can organize the arrival schedule.
