# **Project description**

A project **Effective Communication Tools for You(th)** is a mobility of youth workers aimed on development of communication and interpersonal competences of 30 youth workers, educators, teachers and project managers from 14 European countries.

The project will take place in *Radava*, *Slovakia* in dates of *23rd - 31st of August 2019*.
