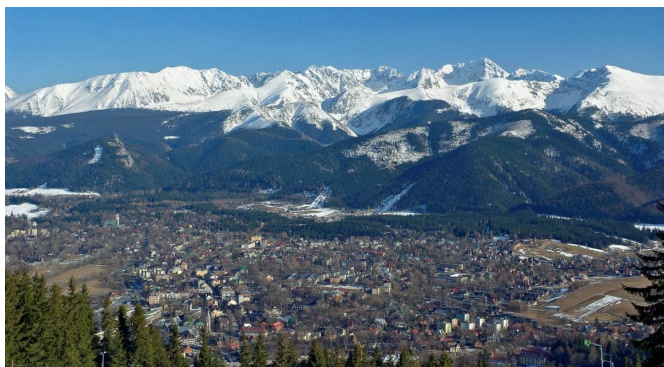

How to reach Zakopane

There are two nearest airports – one in Kraków (KRK), and one in Katowice (KTW). These airports and cities are very well connected with Zakopane thanks to buses, which run from the early morning to the late evening. From Katowice to Zakopane the bus costs about 10-20 € and from Kraków to Zakopane about 5-10€.

About the project

Macedonia, Turkey, Italy, Bulgaria, Romania, Lithuania, Spain, Greece, Malta, Estonia	275 EUR (per person)

The project will be hosted in „Krzesanica” resort. The participants will live in rooms for 2 people, each room is equipped with en suite bathroom. There will be two conference rooms to our disposal, where we will work and do our programme activities.
