

- Create a space to share best practices and develop co-operation among participants from NHSM member organisations



FROM THE AIRPORT

The town of Cañete de la Real is 80 km from the city of Malaga (approximately 1 hour and 10 minutes by car).



HOW TO ARRIVE FROM MÁLAGA AIRPORT TO MÁLAGA BUS STATION

EXPRESS AIRPORT that has a peak frequency of 20-25 minutes, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The price of the ticket is 3€. There are two possibilities to buy the travel title, first the checkpoint located at the exit of the terminal, where you can pay in cash or by credit card. Second, pay directly inside the bus in cash.

HOW TO ARRIVE FROM MÁLAGA BUS STATION TO ALHAURÍN DE LA TORRE

You can take buses line: 133, 132 and 230. You must get off at the "La Torre" stop and walk to the Youth House (in front of the City Hall of Alhaurín de la Torre). The price it's 1,70 € and there are buses each 45 minutes (aprox.) until 22.45 h.

We'll do it using the **PECHAKUCHA WAY**:


20 images, 20 seconds each, and connected seamlessly with well-developed narration are your only rules.

Please bring them mainly from your own country, because in the hostel you can only use the microwave, and you **will be allowed to use the kitchen**.









REIMBURSEMENT

The organizers will reimburse 100% of participants' travel costs (with cheapest means of transportation (economy class), **(no taxi)** within limits set by Erasmus+ Programme upon presentation of original tickets, invoices and boarding tags. On all documents the price, currency, name of the passenger, date of purchase and travel should be clearly visible, otherwise we will be unable to reimburse the costs.

- → Participants will receive **reimbursements by bank transfer after the seminar** and upon sending of return travel documents and international bank details. No exception to this rule will be done.
- If it is possible bring with you a document to have made a bank transfer in advance where the owner of the account and the account number appear.
- Reimbursement will be done in **EUR**, regardless of the currency indicated on the ticket and receipt/ invoice. Any tickets purchased in a local currency other than EUR, will then be converted and calculated according to the exchange rate.






YOUTHPASS
