We work in an unconventional way and focus on non-formal education. We have been operating since 2015, and in the first year of our activity we have had several strong projects on the Polish educational market, one of them being awarded the EDUinspiration of Ministry of Education in Poland.

GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE PROJECT

The role of the youth leader is to show the young person the direction in which to look, without imposing on him what to see.

We live in a world that is changing very dynamically and we, as youth leaders, have to help young people prepare for every eventuality. None of us can be sure that he or she will have a job that will do all life. That is why the role of a youth leader is so important.

Through practical learning, a leader is able to equip young people with the skills and competences that will allow them to move freely in the labour market. But what does it mean to be a youth leader?

In order to guide young people well, YL must have the competences and knowledge necessary to help young people. That's why our association wants to organise training – to help youth leaders, who are just starting out, to understand what it is all about.

That is why we organize training for young leaders.

Each of us once started and searched for opportunities to gain knowledge about how to be a good youth leader.

We believe that our training will be a very good opportunity for leaders from different countries of the European Union to share their experiences, expectations of being a leader, as well as their fears.

Moreover, we want our project to give them a mutual opportunity for networking.



Through the project, we would like to:

- Familiarize youth leaders with the types of European certification;
 - Make participants aware of what it means to be a youth leader, and what kind of youth leader has an impact on shaping youth;
 - Increase the knowledge of the role of non-formal education in youth leader's work;
- Equipping the leader with competences for facilitation and knowledge necessary for proper performance of his work;
- Increase the knowledge of youth leaders about the development opportunities they can offer to their pupils;

Familiarize youth leaders with types of competences (e. g. Youthpass Key Competences);

Enabling youth leaders from partner countries to discuss and exchange good practices.


We try to make sure that during the project participants bring out as much knowledge as possible. **The schedule will**be tight and a lot of work awaits you during the training.

RECRUITMENT

- Project partners are responsible for recruiting. Once your membership has been approved by the organization, we will send you an application form. You have to fill it till 25.03.
- The next step is to join to our Facebook group (click). This group is used for communication between participants before the project. Please be active in the group and follow the information that will appear before the project, we want each participant to be properly prepared for our project.
- Until 07.04.2019 you have to send us a plan
 of your trip and a confirmation of your
 purchase, otherwise we may treat it as a
 cancellation of your participation.

From there you have to take train

which in Poland is called **KM or SKM** and go to the

Central Station.

Then you have to take a train to **OLSZTYN GŁÓWNY**.

When you'll be at Olsztyn Główny Station, you have to take a bus no 101.

Travel costs are reimbursed under the condition of participation in **ALL ACTIVITIES.**

Only class II or Economy Class tickets are eligible for reimbursement of costs (airplane, train, bus). Taxi and car are not eligible for reimbursement.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATIONS

As a member of the European Union, Poland has agreements for the recognition of insurance systems.

Those who possess a **European insurance card** should therefore be covered for illness and accidents in the same way as they are in their country, **please bring with you this** card (click here)

The currency in Poland is **ZLOTY.**Most used credit cards are American Express, Visa and MasterCard/EuroCard.

In Poland silent hours are from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.

In Poland, there is a **total ban on drinking alcohol in public places** such as railway stations, parks, streets.

Breaking this law threatens **the mandate of the altitudes of 100 zł = 25 euro**

In Poland, there **is also a ban on smoking** in public places such as cinemas, theaters, railway stations, airports, and bus stops. Sometimes in these places it is a special place for smoking.
