Summary of the project

The activity of "New Bridges For Youth Inclusion" project will take place on 05-12 January 2019 in Gaziantep /Turkey. The main themes of the project are European awareness and cooperation between the organisations which works in youth field and inclusion of the young persons with fewer opportunities in European projects.

The general aim of the project is to create an environment to establish new partnerships and exchanging experiences about EVS among the associations which are involved or intend to be involved in EVS .

The organisations in this projects are accredited organizations or have intention to be accredited in EVS field. The project activity will be based on the principles and practice of non-formal education methods taking into account the needs and motivations of participants.

Objectives:

- to create an environment for the new partnerships in Evs
- to have the organisation be more active and conscious for Evs
- to gain new ideas together
- to share experiences about Evs
- to sharing good experiences and problems about EVS
- to create an environment to learn about the cultures of the participants from different European countries.

Working Language:

The language of the project will be only English.

Working Methods

Our training will be based on non-formal learning. It means that learning is based on your experience, your motivation and your needs. You are responsible for your learning but the team of trainers and participants group will support you. During the training non-formal education methods and methods that assure balance between theory and practice will be used

such as workshops, discussions, group works, interactive lectures, simulation games, role plays, exercises etc.

Target Group

Target group of this course are youth leaders, youth workers, EVS coordinators and support persons. There will 2 participants from each partners.

Tasks for the sending organisations:

- to find motivated and experienced participants till 1st November 2019 and inform the coordinator organisation about the participants.
- to assist travel arrangements
- to warn the participants about the travel documents for reimbursement.
- to inform them about the schedule, tasks,duties and rules.

Tasks For the participants:

- to fill in the Participant Form and send it by e-mail to **kbey20@hotmail.com** untill 5th of November , 2018. Please let us know if you have any problem about finding participants.
- to search and inform us about the details of the tickets till **15th November 2018** and buy them **AFTER GETTING CONFIRMATION** from the coordinator of the project and send the e-ticket by e-mail till 25th November, 2018 the latest. **The ticket bought without any getting confirmation from us will not be valid and reimbursed.**
- to inform the hosting organization about the arrival
- to attend in the all sessions of the project activity.
- to provide all the travel documents (tickets,boarding passes, visa documents, etc.) to get the travel reimbursement.

Participation Fee

There will 15 Euro participation fee for each participant. It will be paid by participants during the activity.

- Please learn more about your sending organization, activity field and info about it because there will be a session that you will introduce your sending organization.

Reimbursement of Travel Cost

Pease, read very carefully the following information in order to facilitate our work and for you to have a pleasant travel and stay.

- You will be reimbursed your travel costs from your home city to Gaziantep, Turkey. Your reimbursement will be paid **DURING** the activity after you deliver us all the documents about your travel. Accommodation and meals will be covered us.
- All tickets must be in economic class. You can arrange your travel maximum 2 days before/after the project activity dates. In this case, you will be **RESPONSIBLE** for your accommodation for the extra days.

- Reimbursement of travel costs will only be done upon presentation of all documents about travel such as e-tickets, tickets, boarding passes (including return tickets and boarding passes) according to real prices.
- Please **Do Not** lose the boarding passes that will be given to you at the check-in desk at the airport or you have printed after you make online check in. Boarding pass is required for having an evidence for your flight and you must deliver them to the coordinator to get your reimbursement.
- The prices on the TICKETS ,not on the invoices, will be regarded while your reimbursement will be calculated.
- Reimbursement will be done in EURO, regardless of the currency indicated on your ticket. If you bought your ticket in a local currency other than EURO, we will calculate your travel costs according to the exchange rate of the month of contract of the project.
- The travel reimbursements will be done according to **REAL** cost on the tickets in the limit of the maximum amount. Please check the table above for the maximum travel reimbursement limits. If your travel costs exceed the maximum amount for your country, we will only be able to reimburse you up to the maximum travel costs indicated in the table. You are strongly advised to book your travel well in advance.
- It would be better if your tickets are in euro, otherwise we will get lost in calculating the exchange rates.
- Finally, please send your e-tickets and by e-mail to kbey20@hotmail.com before you come to the activity. This will be very helpful to organizers to begin processing the financial and reimbursement data.

Visa

Turkey is not in the EU yet so please bring along your passport.

There is a need for visas for some countries citizens.

Please check the visa procedure from the consulate of Turkey in your country.

Budget for visa cost is around **15 Euro** per participant.

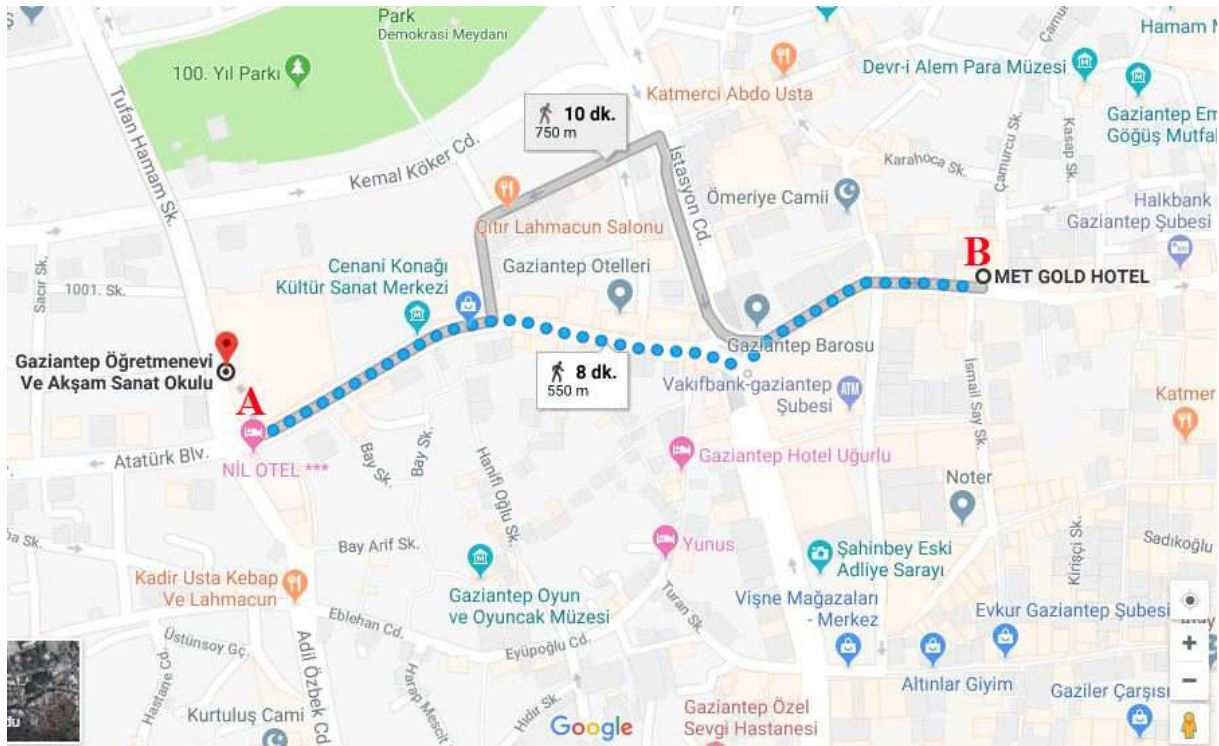
Currency

The currency in Turkey is the **Turkish Lira (TL)** (1 EURO = around 7 TL) However you should check it near the activity date as the currency is so changeable nowadays.

How to get to Hotel

Gaziantep Airport is 20 km far from the hotel. So, you can take the shuttle bus from the airport. You can see the shuttle bus opposite of the exit door written as "HAVAS" on it. You are expected to get off at the bus stop "YESILSU / OGRETMEN EVI" in the center. You can walk from the bus stop to the hotel because it is only 550 m or if you want you can take a taxi. However, the taxi costs will not be reimbursed. It will only cost around 3 or 4 Euro.

You can see the map about how to reach to the Met Gold Hotel from the "OGRETMEN EVI" bus stop. **A** is the bus stop and **B** is Met Gold Hotel in the map.



About Gaziantep

Gaziantep is a province in south-central Turkey. The city has two districts under its administration, Sahinbey and Sehitkamil with a total population of 1,844,438 (2013) and an

area of 2138 km². The urban population is 1,175,042. This makes it the sixth largest city of Turkey and it is the largest city in Turkey's Southeastern Anatolia Region.

An important trading center since ancient times, the province is also one of Turkey's major manufacturing zones, and its agriculture is dominated by the growing of pistachio nuts.



In ancient times, first the Hittites and later the Assyrians controlled the region. It saw much fighting during the Crusades, and Saladin won a key battle there in 1183. After World War I and Ottoman Empire's disintegration, it was invaded by the forces of the French Third Republic during the Turkish War of Independence. It was returned to Turkish control after the Treaty of Lausanne was signed, formally ending hostilities between Turkey and the Allies of World War I.



Originally known as Antep, the title gazi (meaning veteran in Turkish) was added to the courage during the Turkish War of Independence



History

Gaziantep is probably the site of the Hellenistic city of Antiochia ad Taurum ("Antiochia in

the Taurus Mountains"). A few km to the north are the ruins of Greek and Roman Doliche

Gaziantep is one of the most developed provinces of the region and is also one of the oldest, its history reaching as far back as the Hittites. Being the center of pistachio nut cultivation in Turkey and with its extensive olive groves and vineyards, Gaziantep is one of the important agricultural and industrial centres of Turkey.



In the center of the city stands the Gaziantep Fortress and the Ravanda citadel as the reminders of past. The Archaeological Museum, with its important collections from Neolithic and the Hittite ages as well as the Roman and Commagene times, attracts many visitors. The surroundings of the city are also full of valuable Hittite remains. The Hasan Süzer House, which



has been restored to its original beauty, now houses the Ethnographical Museum. The Yesemek Sculpture Workshop, 30 kilometers south of the town of Islahiye, is one of the world's first of this kind.

Some of the other historical remains are the Belkis (Zeugma), and Kargamış Ruins by the town of Nizip. Dülük, which is close to the city center, has camping facilities in a natural setting.
