

## Advanced Planning Visit programme **‘Minorities in Action’**

### First day (28.05.2016, Narva-Jõesuu)

11.00 Arrival

12.00 Getting to know each other, meeting with group leaders, confirming the agenda for the meeting, providing information about national groups, building a strong team spirit by using icebreakers, name games and teambuilding games

14.00 Travelling arrangement to the venue of Youth Exchange, accommodation, food, special needs, health insurance, division of tasks and other necessary practical arrangements. Exploring hostel where participants will live during Youth Exchange. Tasting local food. Visiting conference room where Youth Exchange will be held.

17.00 Participants discuss the topic “Way of integration of ethnic and linguistic minorities into society” in order to expand their horizons, learn to communicate on equal terms with people from other cultures, ethnic and racial groups, to understand how important and what are the best methods to fight discrimination in society.

18.00 Conducting a series of roundtable talks, working in groups and participating in brainstormings. Group leaders and participants share knowledge, ideas and write down the best ways for integration of minorities in their countries.

20.00 Creative evening. Participants invent an anthem of the project for uniting the team. Group leaders, promoters and organizers develop creative potential and create a friendly atmosphere of open communication in the team.
