THEMES OF THE TRAINING COURSE:

Reducing youth unemployment is one of the major challenges facing most governments in Europe and neighboring partner countries. Countries involved in this project show particularly disturbing signs. Europe 2020 Strategy emphasizes a direct link between employment and sustainable development. This problem has been aggravated given the current context concerning young migrants, refugees and asylum seekers in Europe. The frustration and disempowerment of the disadvantaged youth in general can breed low self-esteem and low motivation.

We as youth workers and youth leaders working directly with young unemployed people and disadvantaged youth among refugees'/asylum seekers and migrants are uniquely positioned to inspire and empower youth to be creative, entrepreneurial and business minded through non-formal and informal activities and raise their self-confidence and enthusiasm which leads to promotion of entrepreneurial culture, higher awareness of personal empowerment and inclusion.

THE OVERALL AIM OF THE TRAINING COURSE

"Power to Unlock Your Inner Entrepreneur" aims to train and equip youth workers and youth leaders working directly with young unemployed people and disadvantaged youth from refugees/asylum seekers and migrants with essential entrepreneurial and business tools, methods and skills to enable them to contribute to tackling of the problem of unemployment among youth through quality youth work that promotes self-employment and entrepreneurial culture.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES OF THE TRAINING COURSE

- Introduce youth entrepreneurship as a tool of fighting youth unemployment.
- Support youth workers in developing and sharing effective methods in reaching out to marginalized young people
- Learn to use youth work to empower youngsters to start their creative search for entrepreneurial opportunities.
- Learn to use non-formal education to support current and future job-seekers to be pro-active and able to apply entrepreneurial approach into career development.
- Explore ways for using youth work to bring alienated and marginalized youth back into the economic mainstream and giving them a sense of meaning and belonging
- Learn to use Youthpass and the Key Competences to support young people through creative process of skill harnessing, self-reflection and documentation of the personal learning process.
- Develop quality youth mobility projects to be applied under Erasmus+ Programme.
- Develop and publish online the “Manual for Entrepreneurship Focused Youth Work with Marginalized Young People, Refugees and Migrants”

METHODOLOGY OF THE TRAINING COURSE

The training course will be based on non-formal learning methods and principles, intercultural dialogue and communication including group discussions, interactive presentations, participant's lead workshops, team work, etc. The project aims to reveal the value of the Erasmus+ Programme as a tool for youth empowerment and raise awareness about Youthpass tool for supporting young people harness skills and personal growth through self-reflection and learning documentation.

PRACTICAL CONDITIONS

- When you plan your travel, please try to arrive in Lisbon before 18h on 20 May 2017, we will pick all participants in Lisbon at 19.30h on 20 May 2017. Meeting point in airport(in front Metro station, when you arrive in airport go to your right, you find a red modern building, is there, someone from "H2O" is waiting there for you;
- Bring all documents print, boarding pass, tickets, clear invoices from air company;
- Bring your identification and European health card if you have it;
- You can come 1 or 2 days before and leave 1 or 2 days after;
- Inform us as ASAP about visa, we have to send you invitation;
- We only accept participants that fill register form

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

The food and accommodation will be provided and paid by the organizers. Travel costs will be reimbursed either by bank transfer after the course or at the end of the course in cash (in Euros €). It may be that money from European Commission will be late; in that case, as mentioned, you will get your reimbursement after the course by bank transfer (be ready for that). After coordinator organization received all docs(boarding pass, tickets, clear invoices from air company,) and report in mobility tool, coordinator organization send link to all participants after project to fill it.
