

Infopack "Sea of history" 4-11.11.2017, Będzin, Poland

"Sea of history" is a meeting of young people from Poland, the Czech Republic and Turkey, which will take place between 4-11 of November, 2017. The project is attended by 36 young people. The purpose of the project is to discover common roots, to learn history in the context of multiculturalism, to spread the attitude of a conscious Europeans whose worldview is free from harming stereotypes, hatred but full of tolerance and understanding. During the exchange, there will be number of activities, such as: interdisciplinary workshops, city games, quizzes that will bring us closer to the desired goal. During our exchange we will use various non-formal education methods. The key element of our project is interaction with the local population. In cooperation with the students of the nearby high school we will create a mural painting "Sea of History" and plant "Tree of Tolerance". Our project will contribute in the process of building a happy, stereotype-free, tolerant, multicultural, United Europe.

The project will be attended by <u>36 people from Czech Republic, Turkey and Poland (12 people per national team: 2 group leaders and 10 participants aged 16-19).</u>

As a young people and students, we have passions and hobbies, which we wish to develop, therefore we have created this project. We have planned many activities that we are going to realize using methods of non-formal education and using English for communication (integration games, themed activities, discussions, evaluations, city game, national and regional evenings, meetings with local community etc.).

The project will be an opportunity for us to gain valuable experience, knowledge, new friendships and attitudes, that will have a positive influence on our future.
