YOUTH EXCHANGE ON YOUTH UNEMPLOYMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

### Description:

Many young people are facing unemployment. This is due to many different reasons like low educational background, no experience, no skills, high demands from the employers, social difficulties etc. The reasons list is a very long one. What is important is to motivate and empower the young people that they can be who they want, and they are valued and there are more options than actually being an employee.

With this youth exchange we would like to give young people the opportunity to discover the skills they have and the possibilities that are out there. We create an environment for the participants to get to know themselves and their abilities more deeply, and learn about the entrepreneurship world.

### Aim:

This project aims to bring together young minds to tackle the problem of youth unemployment in different regions and to find great solutions for the issue. The project aims to empower young people to find or create their own jobs.

### Objectives:

- To discuss the issue of youth unemployment in various European countries
- To make the young people reflect on their abilities, skills and needs connected with the labor market

- To reduce the youth unemployment rates
- To give young people the knowledge and motivation about entrepreneurship and to empower them to try it out

#### Target group: 4 participants + 1 leader

- Young people that are facing unemployment
- Young people with few or no working experience
- Young people with interest in intercultural learning
- Young people who are interested in the topic and want to contribute
- Participants that have an active attitude!
- Aged 18 – 24 (the group leader has no upper age limit)

#### Time plan and venue:

APV: 1<sup>st</sup> -4<sup>th</sup> March 2019

Date of the exchange: 28<sup>th</sup> April – 6<sup>th</sup> May 2019 (these are the approximate dates, they will be clarified according to the availability of the venue)

Venue: Tartumaa, Estonia (specific venue will be clarified during next months)

#### Group and duration:

The group will consist of 24 participants from 6 countries, and 7 youth leaders. Participating countries are Estonia, Italy, Spain, Hungary, Czech Republic and Greece.

Travel expenses covered up to a certain amount defined by the Distance Calculator
