VENUE: Nuremberg, GERMANY **DURATION:** 25.04. - 3.05.2016



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PROJECT BACKGROUND:

Through this youth exchange we want to encourage youngsters to make a change in their lives to improve, to grow and to catch the different opportunities that life will bring to them and share they ideas and experience. We will aslo learn how to develop an innovative idea and advertise it to others.

AIM OF THE PROJECT:

The aim of the project is to strengthen creativity of young people, help them to develop innovative START UP ideas and show them how to advertise it.

OBJECTIVES:

- rising creativity of young people
- developing the spirit of entrepreneurship and discovering possible ways of implementing own ideas
- developing presentation skills of young people and learning how to promote own ideas
- sharing experience and good practices in developing own business in our countries

CONTENT OF THE PROJECT:

- simulation games and activities developing creativity
- developing a successful business idea and a business plan
- how to present the idea to others?
- simulations and workshops
- Intercultural activities

PARTNER ORGANISATIONS:

Project will be implemented by six youth NGOs and non-formal groups from European Union member states.

Official partner organisations are: Europe4Youth Deutschland (GER), Eruope4Youth Association(POL), European Youth Centre Breclav (CZE), UnitedLithuanianYouth (LTU), Asociatia URBANIAC (ROU), Associazione Culturale Euromoving (ITA).

TARGET GROUP:

FOR THE YOUTH EXCHANGE 5+1: (total: 30 participants + 6 leaders)

Every group should consist od **5 participants and 1 youth leader.** All participants shall be interested in the topic and motivated to participate in the whole duration in the activity. Basic knowledge of English will be helpful but shall not be a selection criteria. Previous background in youth work is no required from participants.

Youth leaders shall be able to communicate in English as well as have a basic experience in European youth projects.

FOR THE APV 1+1: (total: 6 participants + 6 leaders)

Every organisation should send **1 youth leader and 1 participant.** The general rule is that they both should participate in the youth exchange later on.





VENUE:



Both, the APV and the Youth Exchange will be implemented in Nuremberg, Germany. Nuremberg is the second-biggest city within the whole of the Bavaria state, it is a spirited and stimulating city, with the very reach history.

FOR THE YOUTH EXCHANGE:

The youth exchange will take place in Otto-Felix-Kanitz Hause. The hostel is located a little bit out of the city center, but it's easily accessible by public transport – you can get to the old town in less than 15 minutes. Participants will stay in nationaly-mixed rooms (4-5 people each). Food will be provided by the venue.

Due to hard availability of the venue the APV will take place in the smaller hostel close to the city center. As we will be only 12 people we can have a more cozy place located directly next to the entrance to the old town.

The city of Nuremberg has an own airport. Although it is not very popular, many destinations have a very good connection with Nuremberg.

Getting to the city centre is very easy. You just need to take the train "U2" (in front of the arrivals terminal) and it will take you directly to the Main Railway station called "Nurnberg Hauptbahnhof".

In case you don't have a direct connection with Nuremberg you should book your flight to Munich. This is one of the biggest airports in Germany. From Munich you can very easily take a train arriving in the Nuremberg railway station (one hint: try to avoid trains called "ICE" they are very expensive).

More detailed instruction how to get to both hostels will be provided to the selected youth leaders before activities starts.



DURATION:

Project will consist of two activities: APV and the Youth Exchange.

The idea of the APV is to meet with the whole team of youth leaders, discuss the programme of the Youth Exchange and prepare together in the way that it reflects expectations of all partner organisations.

FUNDING CONDITIONS:

Project will be financed under the "ERAMSUS+ Programme, Key Action 1.

100% of **accommodation** and **activity costs** are covered by the programme.

The **international travel costs** are covered according to the rules of ERASMUS+ Programme. Plan your travel to Nuremberg according to the following budget (the same limits applys to the APV).

That means that your travel costs will be fully reimbursed up to the limit, what should be enough to get to Germany from all participating countries – therefore we expect that everybody will get back 100% of the travel. If you spend less for your travel you will get exactly the amount you spent. If you spend more, you will get the amount from the table.

NOTE: Reimbursement of travel costs will only be done upon full attendance of the youth exchange.

Reimbursement will be done in EURO, regardless of the currency indicated on your ticket and receipt/invoice.

PARTICIPATION FEE:

Fee for participation in the exchange will be **20 EUR** and it will be deducted from the reimbursement.



HEALTH INSURANCE:

Health insurance is not provided by the organisers. Remember to take with you your European Insurance Card or purchase health insurance individually.

DON'T FORGET:

- presentation of your country as well as food and drinks for intercultural evening (WARNING: we will use creative methods for the presentation, so no power points/youtube movies will be accepted;-))
- anything that you think will be useful for the programme (books about the topic, CDs, etc...).
- laptop, tablet or any device which allows you to work with the internet;-)
- a towel
- ... and lots of motivation and smiles
