







Participants profile

Each organization will have to select 5 participants.







The mobility will take place in the small and historic town **Tarifa**, in the Province of Cadiz, Andalusia, Spain.



Overlooking the sea, in the southernmost point of Europe and closest to Africa, Tarifa is one of the coastal cities with the greatest tourist projection, becoming the kingdom of windsurfing. Called by Muslims Al-Yazirat Tarif (Island of Tarif) has been an important strategic point as a border area, stronghold against pirate incursions and military enclave in front of the English possessions of Gibraltar.

Of the walls of the ss. X-XVI are two different sections: the first Islamic period that surrounded a smaller enclosure and the second that covers the entire old town. Its idyllic and extensive beaches lashed by the east wind make Tarifa a place of worship for fans of water sports such as windsurfing, kite surfing, flysurfing, the Blokar or scuba diving, among others.

TRAVELLING TO THE VENUE

The best way to reach Tarifa is going to Malaga airport and then taking a bus from there. There are several ways to get into Tarifa as stated below:

A) From Malaga:

If your intention is to travel from Malaga to Tarifa by bus, you could take one of the buses of the company AVANZA BUS or TG COMES. The price for this trip vary between 15 and 18 Euros, being the time of the trip 2 hour and 45 minutes (direct

service), and 4 hours (regular service).

B) From Algeciras:

In case to travel from Algeciras to Tarfia by bus you have to pick up one of the buses of the company COMES consultu here or CTMCG consult here Approximate price of the trip Algeciras – Tarifa is 1-4 Euros.





C) From Cádiz

If you prefer to travel from Cadiz, you have to take one of the COMES company buses that circulate among these two cities every day. The duration of the trip ranges between 1 hour and 15 minutes. You can check the schedules clicking here.

Price of this trip is around 10 Euros.

FINANCE & REIMBURSEMENT OF TRAVEL COSTS

Financial support is from the Spanish National Agency, under the European Commission's "Erasmus+" – programme.

All costs will be covered, except for excessive budget of the international travel.

Travel costs are refundable for participants who attend all the sessions, commit themselves fully to the activities and provide all ORIGINAL tickets, boarding passes and email relating to their travel.

The maximum reimbursement per participant from each country is up to as follows.



TRAVEL & HEALTH INSURANCE

It is mandatory requirement for all participants to provide their own health insurance. This should cover you for the full duration of your time in Spain. You can use the free **European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)** to allow you access to public hospital treatment.

Please be aware that the EHIC is NOT a travel insurance policy, it will not cover private health care, non-emergency health costs or being flown back to you home country. To learn more, please go to:

General travel insurance to cover the safety of your possessions, lost luggage, delays to flights, etc is NOT mandatory requirement, but it is advisable.





DIETARY, HEALTH & OTHER SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Please inform us as soon as possible if you have any food allergies or you have special dietary requirements so that we can inform the caterers and so that they can prepare meals that are suitable for you. If you have any other allergies, need to take regular medications or foresee a need for general medicines during you time in Spain (for example bug spray, headache tables, travel sickness, pills, etc.) please arrange these yourself as we are unable to provide them for you. Likewise, if you have any health conditions, disabilities or mobility issues that you feel we need to be aware of or that may affect your participation in the youth exchanges activities, then please let us know what they are and how best to assist you.

REIMBURSEMENTS

When booking your tickets, please contact your sending organization or us in order to find the best and cheapest transport for you. Only approved tickets will be reimbursed on the basis of the cheapest tickets available, according to the rules of the Erasmus+.

The reimbursement will be transferred to the bank accounts of the leader of the national team or the account of the sending organization. For the exchange rates, we are using the official exchange rates issued by the European Central Bank. The day of the exchange rates is the day of the signature of the financial agreement with the Spanish National Agency. We kindly ask you for patience when expecting the reimbursement. After handing all of your original tickets and payment confirmations, please, give us at least 2 months to process everything.

Please note, that we are able to reimburse your travel expenses only after you help us with the dissemination of the outcomes of the YE (photos, videos, reports, etc.). We will kindly ask you to help us with a report about our YE, sharing it on social media and providing us links and print screens to those activities.





WHAT TO BRING

We have a general tip what to bring to this project! Don't forget a towel and things for a shower, comfortable clothes, slippers, shoes, warm clothes, some repellent against insect and raincoats. Please, keep in mind that we are in near to the sea.

Make sure that each national group will have at least one laptop. In case you have camera or GoPro, do not hesitate to bring it.

- ID or Passport
- Blue health insurance card "EHIC" (if applicable)
- Documents of your insurance valid in Spain
- Signed participant contract (last pages of this infopack)

Contract for participation in the Youth Exchange "Creative Spaceship" Erasmus+ programme, KA1 Ceuta, Spain, November 2-9, 2018

The objectives of this youth exchange are: to raise self, cultural and ethnic awareness through non-formal educational methods and peer education; to develop the key competencies and skills of self-reflection among the participants; to boost creativity skill and encourage its usage in everyday situations, as well as in solving common and global problems; to optimise the effectiveness and creativeness using a competency-based approach; to reinforce understanding and interest in other cultures and their views, concepts and peculiarities through intercultural learning; to promote positive and respectful attitudes toward various cultures, people and their speciality.

What is expected from you?

Behaviour:

- I will follow the rules and guidelines adopted during the Program.
- I will attend all Program sessions. I understand that I may not skip sessions.
- I will not be late for program sessions, and I will participate fully.
- I will not drink alcohol during any workshop, activity or breaks.
- I will not smoke during any workshop or activity.
- I will respect the property of the venue and the property of other participants.
- I will keep my room clean and I will help keep the working session rooms clean and organized.
- I will avoid any conflicts with the police and I will not break local laws.





Exchange & Cultural Sensitivity:

- I will come prepared to discuss Program topics, and I will share my ideas and opinions.
- I will respect the ideas and opinions of the others, as well as each cultural difference.
- I will help with any preparation and set-up needs during the Program.
- I will go to my group leader with all problems and concerns.

Language:

- I will speak English at all times during the working sessions as well as during free time when in groups of people from other countries. I will not use my native language to exclude others.
- I will respect the different levels of languages ability of other participants.
- I will encourage participation from all participants and will not exclude people.

Travel:

- I understand that this is a working youth exchange and not a tourist trip.
- I understand that I will be expected to remain with the group at all times and for the entire exchange.
- I understand that I will have free time and time to relax, but I will not be permitted to travel on my own during the exchange or away from the venue.

Expenses:

- I understand I will be expected to pay for 100% of my travel costs before the Program.
- I understand that I will receive travel costs reimbursement up to the limit according to Erasmus+ rules when hosting organization will get all original travel documents.





 I agree that if I do not follow these rules I can be sent home at any time, and at my own expense. I understand that if I am sent home early I will not receive any reimbursement for travel. Additionally, if I break or damages any items during the Program I will pay to have them replaced or repaired.

By signing this contract, I agree that I will participate in the youth exchange "Creative Spaceship" for the duration of the program, from 02.11 – 09.11.2018. I also agree that I will be available at least 2 days before and two days after the dates of the Program as it might be needed for the travel.

I understand that I am making a commitment to participate and that I will not be allowed to cancel my participation once I have committed.
