THE PROJECT

Periplus 2.0 is a **Partnership Building Activity** for youth workers planned in the frame of the KA1 of the Erasmus Plus Programme and to be hosted by the Italian network SEYF.

The project is coordinated from **SEYF's network** and foresees the participation of **13 European Organizations from 13 EU countries** from South Europe (Italy,



Spain, Portugal, Bulgaria, Malta and France) and North Europe (Germany, Czech Republic, United Kingdom, Ireland, Finland, Sweden and Estonia).

The project actively involves 27 beneficiaries through the participation of **2 participants** per NGO: specifically, a youth worker and a board/decision member, in order to recreate and stimulate the dialogue between the different actors in the youth system.

Periplus 2.0 is a concrete follow up of a previous **networking activity** (Periplus) and represents the results of a longstanding international cooperation developed in the youth field from 2010 to 2014.

As the etymology says, Periplus comes from the Latinization of an ancient Greek word (periplus) that literally means circumnavigation and it refers to the Captain's diary. On the same line, Periplus is intended to be a **story of the young side of Europe through the construction of reliable partnership of European youth organizations**; a tale about the youth work in each EU country; a novel about the tools at disposal of the youth for increasing occupational opportunities.

Thus, Periplus 2.0, as a follow up of previous successful activities, is going to create a new concept of partnership based on:

- **Participatory approach**: the partnership is intended to be long-lasting and built up on the practice of participatory planning;

- **Sustainability**: the partnership is going to foster European Citizenship (think global), bringing the added value of each country and NGO (act local);
- **Innovation**: the partnership is going to be implemented on a **mobile APP** which will stimulate partner to be involved and active in the **planning, development and implementation of EVS projects**.

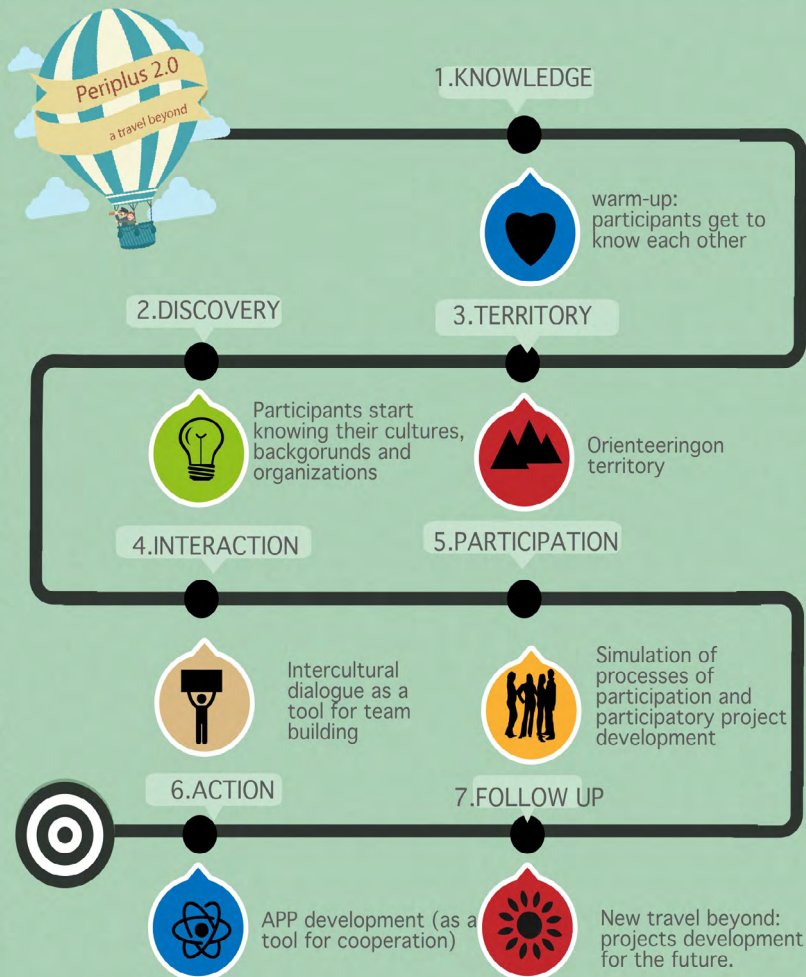
Periplus 2.0 will investigate the world of youth and youth work in order to stimulate the creation of new projects within the Erasmus Plus Programme, within the development of EVS projects, through the analysis of the most appropriate actions to the different realities and situations.

Periplus, as a Partnership Building Activity, will explore the possibility to create a strong partnership through **non-formal activities that will stimulate a confident climate and will create a strong mood for best practices and strong (human, cultural and professional) relations**.

The project is going to be implemented between **17th - 24th November 2015**.

Arrival day: you should arrive during the day of **17th November 2015**.

WHERE



According to the most typical touristic Italian accommodation, participants will be hosted in **Lecce**, a beautiful city in the South of Italy, near the Adriatic Sea, famous at international level for a European Festival of traditional folk dance.

You are going to be hosted in Bed&Breakfast of the city, living as Italian people for a week. In each apartment there will be about 3-4 people, mixed for nationalities, in order to foster intercultural dialogue. Participants are going to be grouped by sex.

Activities will be implemented in the wonderful Convitto Palmieri, an historical place.

TRANSPORTATION

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS



- As usual, food and accomodations are provided and paid by Italian organization;
- **IMPORTANT:** If you are not travelling from your country please tell us in advance because our National Agency may not accept the travel cost and the project expenses!

Covered costs:

As foreseen by the Erasmus Plus Programme, it is covered the amount for **travel costs** in relation to the distance from you home-place to Lecce. In particular:

* participants from **Bulgaria, Germany, Czech Republic, Spain, Sweden, Malta, France:** It is covered the amount of **275,00 € per participant;**

* participants from **Estonia, Finlandia, United Kingdom, Ireland, Portugal, :** It is covered the amount of **360,00 € per participant.**

- You should buy your tickets and bring them with you in Italy the invoice and the boarding Pass.

- ATTENTION!!! You can already buy your tickets;

- The invoice must be headed to SEYF or the the individual participant. (**SEYF - South Europe Youth Forum - Via Vecchia Comunale per Tricase 4 - 73032 - Andrano (LE) - Italian Fiscal code/VAT: 90036240753**)

- When you'll give this documents to SEYF Staff you'll receive the reimbursement.

- Everyone has to keep boarding passes and give them to SEYF Staff.

- The **membership SEYF fee** will be of **€ 20.00** per participant.

- Please provide to insure yourself: **insurance** is not covered by the project's costs.
