ABOUT THE ORGANISATION



Info-Integration - Belgian Red Cross is the reference centre for migration and integration in the German speaking Community of Belgium.

Our main tasks are:

- the consultation of clients on topics such as right of residence and residency permits, right to international protection, family reunification etc.
- the supervision of the participants of the Integration Pathways in the German Speaking Community of Belgium
- awareness campaigns and public relations
- counselling and supervision of schools with focus on diversity and interculturality
- workshops and trainings

ABOUT THE PROJECT



The volunteer will assist us with already existing projects such as awareness campaigns to prevent xenophobia and racism in the German Speaking Community or workshops with schools.

Typical tasks for the volunteer would be:

- create and further develop of school workshop about asylum, displacement, human rights and racism prevention
- support the staff in ongoing campaigns and projects (Living Library, Meet and Eat, Film Festival, etc.)
- support the staff with creating content for Facebook, our website and other publications

Our volunteer - depending on her/his own abilities and interests - also has the opportunity to create their own project. The goals of this project will be defined with the team at the beginning of the project.

PRACTICALITIES

Our office is located in Eupen, a small city close to the German border, with about 19.000 inhabitants.

The accommodation will be in Eupen as well. There are many other volunteers in different projects here and our volunteer will share a flat with a volunteer of another project.

A subscription to the local public transport network will be provided. There will be no food provided by the office but the volunteer will have an allowance to buy their own food.

TRAINING

The volunteer will participate in the On-Arrival and Mid-Term Training sessions organized by the national agency.

The volunteer also has the possibility to attend various trainings given by the Belgian Red Cross.

The volunteer will also have the possibility to attend trainings related to the topics of integration and migration organized by our office or other local institutions.

WHO ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

Having an open mind regarding other people and other cultures is very important for our choice of volunteer.

In addition to that, the volunteer should have particular interest in the topics of migration, asylum and displacement.

Other criteria, such as nationality, gender or religion play a minor role in our selection, but speaking German(B2) is a must.
