



# Stuffed zucchini flower

#### ITALY

Baked stuffed zucchini flowers are a tasty and easy-toprepare recipe of Roman origin. It is an ideal dish to eat as a side dish or appetiser in spring and summer, and is loved by young and old alike.

The filling of baked zucchini flowers can be made with mozzarella and anchovies, as the Romans do, rice, meat, fish or vegetables, as in our case, which make the zucchini flowers lighter than those fried in butter.





### Zemlovkabread pudding

Czech and Slovak Republic

A sweet bread pudding made of apples and old rolls or bread pieces soaked in sweet milk.

The pastry is soaked in milk flavoured with sugar and cinammon. A layer of wet pastry is put on the bottom and a layer of apples is spread on top- zou stack several layers like this.

The fruit is also sprikled with raisins and powder sugar, the mixture is baked until golden.





# Pesto from carrot leaves

#### Czech

Boil carrot leaves in water for 3 minutes. Spill out water and add salt, garlic and olive oil.

Then put pesto in a glass box and leave it to get cold. You can use pesto for pasta or bread.





# Baked sweet potatoes

Romania

Thorougly wash the potatoes, cut them as small as you would like them, put them on a tray on the baking paper, add some oil and spices and ENJOY!


Instead of wasting paper that has "no more use", people should find ways of using it wisely.



#### Art 4 Enviroment


In this workshop we recycle materials such as newspaper, cartoon, box from wine. We created art work inspired by environmental topic.

# What percentage of paper is recycled in Europe?

In 2019, 72% of all paper and board consumed in Europe was recycled. The collection of paper for recycling decreased by 2.5% compared to 2018 and reached 57.5 million tonnes.

Paper and board consumption has decreased more strongly compared to 2018 and dropped to 79.8 million tonnes.



FERTILIZER & COMPOST

Compost is a sustainable option for fertilizing and there are a lot of options to create it on your own.

Not only that it is beneficial to the society, but also picking up trash from the nature is a nice way of spending some time with the right people around.



- PARSLEY








## CONCLUSION
